

Getting started in motorcycle sport couldn't be easier.

- 1. Decide which discipline you'd like to get involved in
- 2. Contact one of our <u>associated clubs</u> that support that discipline and become a member
- 3. Create your online profile via the riders portal
- 4. Update your online profile by choosing which club you're a member of (the club secretary will then confirm this via the riders portal)
- 5. Once confirmed, click on the 'membership' tab on the riders portal and add the relevant licence type (your club or the <u>SACU Office</u> can advise you on this)
- 6. Register for any practice or competition events via the riders portal (coming soon)

STARTING QUADS

<u>Discipline Guide</u>

Quad racing is the 4-wheeled equivalent of a Motocross event. Open aged and open gendered races take place on an off road track to determine who can jump the highest, leap the furthest or go the fastest to reach the chequered flag. A truly inclusive sport, Quad racing is fun for the whole family. In fact, many third generation riders are now starting to race!

<u>Licence Type</u>

With no upper age limit, anyone can begin Quad racing from as young as 6 years old! No need for a driving licence, but you will need a SACU 'Motocross Competition Licence' (£25 - £48, engine dependant). Event entry fees start from £45 youth, £60 adult. Club Membership is £30 youth, £40 adult.

Equipment Needed

Quad bikes can be purchased from a variety of dealers across the country, buy used from £300. (NB: Before purchasing a Quad, please speak to us as Quad dimensions and modification criteria need to be considered. You will



also need a helmet bearing the ACU gold or silver stamp (prices start from around £30).
