

# Chairperson of the Board of Directors

Role Type: Voluntary

Elected Role: The Chairperson is nominated by member clubs and elected at the AGM; they will sit for a three-year period and may stand for further re-election

#### About the Role

The SACU Management Committee is responsible for the management and organisation of the SACU and its assets. The Chairman is responsible for the leadership and direction of the SACU.

### About the SACU

The Scottish Auto Cycle Union (SACU) is the National Governing Body for motorcycle sport in Scotland. The SACU develops and promotes a number of motorcycle disciplines including:

- Road Race (inclusive of sidecars)
- Trials
- Off Road Speed (Motocross, Enduro, Quads and Supermoto
- Bike Trials (non-motorised)

Formed in 1913, the SACU now has over 40 affiliated clubs which organise in excess of 180 events each year for all ages and abilities across 94 permitted venues; some of which are Forestry and Land Scotland partnerships. The SACU issues competition licences, event insurance and provides training for officials and coaches. Each sporting discipline has its own committee, elected by the clubs, to help promote and develop their sport

## Key Responsibilities

- Build a cohesive team of Directors and successfully deliver the aims of the SACU
- Responsible for leading meetings and reporting on any actions relevant to the conduct of the SACU
- Oversee the successful year on year workings of the SACU and its Sporting Disciplines
- Lead the Board of Directors and discipline Directors in line with the ethical codes adopted by the SACU



- Delegate roles and tasks to suitably qualified individuals
- Work with and encourage links with external organisations in the furtherance of the aims of the SACU
- Work and continue to develop strong working relationships with the ACU
- Liaise with **sport**scotland and other sports governing bodies at a strategic level
- Work with the Chief Operating Officer to secure sportscotland investment as and when contractually required

## Expenses

The post is voluntary although travel and meeting expenses will be reimbursed according to the SACU Constitution.
