SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Jurisdiction: The meeting will be held under the National Sporting Code, Environmental Code and Motocross Standing Regulations of the ACU, SACU 2018 edition, these Supplementary Regulations, SACU Motocross Regulations and any further instructions or official announcements made.

Event start: Scrutineering / sign on from 2pm to 4.30pm Friday 13th / 8am – 9am Saturday 14th / 8am – 8.30am Sunday 15th – Practice 10am Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th.

Body Armor: For 2018 Riders **MUST** wear body armour which covers both chest and back, from 2019 all riders must wear body armour covering chest and back as per SACU and ACU **EN1621-2 (back)** and **EN1621-3(chest)** legislation, riders not wearing body armour will be disqualified from the race.

Entries: Having entered the event, if you become a non-starter you must explain your absence to the promoting club, Entries must be made online or on the official paper entry form. All entrants must show their club membership card and license when signing on at the event, all riders must hold a valid licence, any current valid licence accepted.

Non SACU/ACU Licence holders must pay SACU/ACU Supplement of £5, one event licence are available at **£15** and can be downloaded at www.sacu.co.uk, the club reserves the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason.

Entry details: Open on publication, close Fri 30th June 2018. Fee's: £45 per day.

Cheque and postal orders must be payable to **The Galloway Motorcycle Club**. To be sent to the secretary of the meeting.

Overseas riders: all overseas riders must produce a start permission document from their governing body.

Refund policy: If you enter a meeting and then have a valid reason why you won't be able to attend and would like a refund of your entry fee, you must contact the secretary of the meeting before 8pm the Thursday before the event. No refunds will be given after practice.

Insurance: The SACU has arranged **Public Liability Insurance** Insured with **XL London Market Ltd – Lloyd Syndicate 1209** and **QBE Insurance (Europe) Ltd** and **Personal Accident Insurance** insured with **DTW 1991 Underwriting Ltd on behalf of DTW1991 at Lloyds**, for protection of their clubs, officials and licence holders, for events which are run under a SACU permit or certificate of exemption of permit

Machines: Pre-84, Air Cooled, Drum Brake front and rear, In good working order and race worthy, as per stated class and passed by the club's technical officers, all machines must be fitted with an engine cut out button.

Scrutineering: All bikes – Helmets and Body armor must be scrutineered and passed by the club's technical officers. Scrutineers decision is final.

Clothing: All riders must wear **Helmet(with current ACU stamp) – Gloves – Knee length protective boots – Goggles(non splinterable)(tear-offs are strictly banned) – SACU/ACU approved body armour**. Spectacles if worn must be non-splinterable.

Course: 1.5 miles of undulating land: Start method – Start gate.

Event schedule: The Galloway Motorcycle club reserve the right to alter or amend the event schedule at their discretion.

Environment: power washing is prohibited – use bins/skips provided for all your rubbish: **Dumping of oil is strictly prohibited and will incur a penalty of instant dismissal from the event, Tear offs are strictly prohibited and will incur a penalty of instant dismissal from the event.**

Finish: Riders must complete at least 50% of the distance of the winner and pass the chequered flag to be classed as a finisher.

Transponders: Transponders will be used at this event, all transponders must be **MY LAPS** compatible, Transponders will be available to hire at a cost of **£10** for the duration of the event, damaged or lost transponders will incur a charge at the discretion of the hire provider.

Flag signals: As per SACU/ACU guidelines, Please take note of the following rule change regarding flag signals:

Waved yellow: Great danger, be prepared to stop, no overtaking, a significant reduction in speed must be seen, jumps should not be attempted.

Fuel: All fuel used must comply with the 2018 ACU fuel regulations

Fire safety: All riders MUST carry a 2kg dry powder fire extinguisher

Concussion: All riders MUST notify the club of any recent (within the last 23 days) concussion injury and will produce a doctors note to state they are able to compete in the event, the doctors note must state (The rider is no longer suffering the consequences of concussion).

Riding in the paddock: riders must travel at walking pace at all times and stay on the designated roadways.

Illegal Riding: Anyone found riding on the track outwith races or misbehaving in the paddock will be disqualified from the event.

Animals: All animals must be kept on a leash at all times

Pre-68; Bikes manufactured before 31st December 1967

Pre-75; Bikes manufactured before 31st December 1974

Pre-78; Bikes manufactured before 31st December 1977

Twinshock; Bikes manufactured from 1st January 1978 to 31st December 1983
