

Licence Restrictions for those new to Road Racing in Scotland

Choice of licence – 18 and over – Clubman or Clubman Intermediate;

12 to 17 Youths - Clubman

Adults (18 and over)	New to racing, no licence to ride a motorcycle on the public roads. Select CLUBMAN	Restricted to:- 600cc four stroke, 675cc triple, Up to 250cc GP machine. 650cc Classic bike. <i>Once National Licence obtained (after 10 signatures, 2 circuits), Unlimited cc.</i>
Adults (18 and over)	New to racing, full DVLA licence for motorcycle on public roads.	No restriction on Class. Select CLUBMAN INTERMEDIATE
New to racing:- Clubman Licence <i>Unlike Motocross, actual birthday is the change date of age group.</i>		
12 years old	Up to 80cc GP spec, treaded tyres Up to 125cc Production based machine Up to 250cc single cylinder 4 stroke Production machines (restricted) Allowable Class – Formula 125	
13 years old	Up to 400cc Single or twin cylinder 4 stroke Production machine (restricted) to 37 bhp. Would run with Formula 125	
14 years old	Up to 125cc GP Spec machine Up to 250cc 4 stroke single or twin cylinder machine (unrestricted) Allowable Class - Lightweights	
15 or 16 years old	Up to Formula 400 spec or 450cc Production based machine Up to 500cc single or twin cylinder 4 stroke machine Up to 650cc single or twin cylinder 4 stroke Production based machine Allowable Class - Lightweights	
17 years old	Any Classic or Vintage machine Up to Formula 600 or Supersport 600 specification machine 600cc 4 cylinder or 675cc 3 cylinder 4 stroke Production based machine Up to 250cc Grand Prix machine.	
Youths with National Licence experience allows:-		
13 years old	Up to 125cc GP Spec machine Up to 250cc 4 stroke single or twin cylinder machine (unrestricted) Up to 400cc Single or twin cylinder 4 stroke Production machine (restricted) to 37 bhp.	
14 years old	Up to Formula 400 spec or 450cc Production based machine Up to 500cc single or twin cylinder 4 stroke machine Up to 650cc single or twin cylinder 4 stroke Production based machine <i>(Next differs to the 2016 change in ACU Handbook) In Scotland, a National Licence and minimum age is 14.</i> Aprilia RRV450 Restricted or Unrestricted.	
16 years old	Any Classic or Vintage machine Up to Formula 600 or Supersport 600 specification machine 600cc 4 cylinder or 675cc 3 cylinder 4 stroke Production based machine Up to 250cc Grand Prix machine.	
17 years old	Unlimited capacity machine	

SIDECARS

There are no restrictions for ADULT sidecar drivers or passengers.

Passengers can compete at 16 years old on Formula 2, Formula 350, Classic, Vintage or Morgan 3-wheeler sidecar.

Drivers can compete at 17 years old on Formula 2, Formula 350, Classic, Vintage or Morgan 3-wheeler sidecar.
