

Job Title: National Development Manager

Location: Scotland (flexible based, in and around partner offices as required)

Salary: £23,000 - £25,000 (Full-time)

Scottish Motor Sports (SMS) are seeking a National Development Officer to support our National Development Officer in the delivery of our development strategy of two and four wheel motor sport in Scotland.

About SMS

Scottish Motor Sports was established in 2011 as a collaboration between the bodies that govern two and four wheel motor sport; the Scottish Auto Cycle Union (SACU) and the Motor Sports Association, now known as Motorsport UK. Through this new collaborative approach, we are creating an alignment within the Scottish motor sport community enabling SMS to speak with one voice representing the best interests of the whole sport to the Scottish Government, key agencies and legislators.

All applicants must display a strong understanding of the principles of sport development and how these are applied to our club and other organisations helping to shape the organisation against our vision: *“To put motor sport at the heart of the Scottish sporting landscape”*.

Main purpose of the role:

The National Development Officer will play an integral role in the continued delivery of the 2016-2020 strategy. The role will be focussed around club development and the delivery of initiatives that aim to increase participation in grass roots motor sports. They will assist in delivering a new strategy as we move into our new funding cycle.

Key responsibilities:

Reporting to the National Development Manager key responsibilities will be to:

- Work in partnership with designated governing bodies, two and four wheel clubs to deliver motor sport ‘taster session’ events that aim to encourage new people to try motor sports of all disciplines
- Support clubs with the development and implementation of their own development plans
- Build relationships within Higher and Further Education institutions to support the creation of new student motorsport clubs
- Work closely with the National Development Manager to increase and develop the coaching workforce in Scotland
