3rd & 4th Rounds - SACU Classic Championship

- VENUE:-** Berryfell Farm, near Hawick, TD9 9UD (nearest postcode)
- DATE/TIME:-** Saturday 22nd (12:30 Start) & Sunday 23rd June 2019 (10:30 Start)
- ENTRY FEE:-** Adults: £ 45.00 for both days, £25.00 for 1 day, Youths: £ 25.00 for both days, £15.00 for 1 day. Cheques payable to SCRMC
- COURSE:-** The trial will be of a sporting nature and will have 4 laps of 10 sections with 2 routes each day.

Events run as Open Trials. Any member of an ACU/ SACU Affiliated club can enter the trial.

To be held under the National Sporting Code rules of the SACU, the Standing Regulations for trials, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions which may be issued up until the start of the trial. The method of marking for this trial will be TSR22B (no stop).

All dogs must be kept on a lead at all time by order of the farmer. Rough camping is available at the trial Start area from 6pm for Friday & Saturday only.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS. (please read carefully)

1. No "Fun bikes" or non-competitive bikes will be allowed on the ground.
2. "NON-STOP" (TSR22B) method of marking will be used.
3. Trials Registration Card or Licence **MUST** be shown when signing on at the start.
4. Method of deciding ties: - TSR23, ie most cleans, if still tied – most 1s, most 2s, etc.
5. Sections will be closed by a backmarker. Time will be advised at riders briefing, along with any final instructions.
6. All riders on combustion engine machines, except Pre '65 machines, must have a cut out device connected to the rider by a lanyard, max length 1 metre, so as to stop the engine should the rider and machine be parted. Where possible Pre '65 Machines must have a device fitted that will stop the motorcycle engine. Any rider found not wearing the lanyard during the competition will be reported to the Clerk of the Course for further action.
7. Riders NOT competing in the Championship, can choose to ride as a Clubman on either Route, A or B.
8. Cameras fitted to the Rider's helmet or body are not permitted. Cameras attached to the machine are only allowed by permission from the Clerk of the Course.
9. Parents or Guardians of youth(s) signed on must NOT leave the ground.
10. Protests must be received in writing within 5 days of publication of results accompanied by a £100.00 protest fee.
11. Riders must keep to the flagged route.
12. CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: **Thursday 20th June 2019.**
13. IN ORDER TO ACCRUE POINTS IN THE CLASSIC CHAMPIONSHIP, A RIDER **MUST** PRE-ENTER EACH ROUND OF THE CHAMPIONSHIPS. (See SACU classic trials regulations, page 12 para 5).

I/we confirm that I/we are not suspended or my/our SACU Licence has not been suspended/ withdrawn from any SACU competition.

Acknowledgement of the risks of motor sport: I/we understand that by taking part in this event I/we are exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I/we acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the SACU, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I/we may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my/our voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.
