



## **Job Title – Lead Child Protection and Welfare Officer**

**Preamble:** The Board of Directors of the SACU are looking for a new Lead Child Protection and Welfare officer.

Like every organisation that works with young and vulnerable people, the SACU is required under law to have an effective Child Protection Policy and Procedures. The LCPWO is normally an appointed role within the Board Structure nominated by the Chairperson of the SACU, where possible from the existing Board Members. However, in this case we would like to trawl the breadth of our sports to find a new candidate to take the role on. The successful individual would be co-opted as a Vice-President of the SACU.

The successful candidate would work with the Company Secretary to manage and develop the Child Protection and Welfare Policy.

### **Qualifications**

#### **Desirable:**

A working knowledge of current Child Protection and Welfare Legislation  
A strong working knowledge of how Child Protection and Welfare works in society and if possible, within a sporting environment.  
An Interest in Motorcycle Sport

#### **Reporting:**

The Job Holder will report to the Board Of Directors of the SACU and be required to attend Board Meetings at least once quarterly.

## **Job Role – Lead Child Protection and Welfare Officer**

- Work with the Company Secretary to develop, monitor and review the Child Protection and Welfare Policy of the SACU
- Develop a risk management plan to ensure the Board of Directors can effectively deal with incidents as they happen
- Work closely with other directors to advise and support the workings of the policy.
- Represent the SACU at meetings and seminars that fall under the LCPWO's remit
- Undertake the necessary training provided by Safeguarding in Sport on behalf of **sportscotland**
