

Background

As we are all only too well aware, the world has been gripped by a deadly viral pandemic known as Covid-19. As the country recovers from the effects of this pandemic, we as the permit issuing body have a responsibility to our members to look after your health and safety and a responsibility to the wider public to ensure that we are not transmitting the Covid virus as we look to restart our events. With these aims in mind we have had to introduce an additional set of regulations to run alongside our normal event rules.

Please read and understand the rules we have set out as they are designed for your safety. If you can't obey the rules then please don't enter one of our events until we have returned to a more normal operating procedure. If you feel in any way unwell please do not come to the event and similarly if you live with someone who is shielding or in a high risk group please do not come to the event. For the duration of the pandemic online entry fees will be refunded at any point until the allotted start time of the enduro if you inform us that you won't be attending.

These are not designed to be rules to allow us to run Championship events; rather they are simply designed to allow us to restart the sport whilst ensuring that everyone can remain safe until a time when we are allowed to go back to doing things in our usual manner. As per the general SACU guidelines, all events must remain closed to club for the time being.

1. Road Race Entries

Electronic, pre-entered only. On-line entry taken by the organising club. No paperwork processes passed between rider and club.

Organising club to carry out covid-19 risk assessment. This is to ensure all restrictions and guidelines contained within this document have been considered and the risk has been either mitigated or removed.

Entry entourage restricted to:- **solo rider +2, sidecar driver +3** (one of which is the passenger).

Entry to the event only to pre-agreed entrants, officials and marshals.

All riders, are encouraged to bring own food and drink and not share with others outside their team.

2. Preparation of machinery and equipment

All machines presented in a race ready state.

Riders to present machines at scrutineering with paddock stand.

Helmet and leathers must not be worn to scrutineering.

All riders must bring with them face mask and hand sanitiser

3. Arrival at the venue

The Club is responsible for:-

Taking temperatures of all who attend the event, utilising a non-contact method of measurement. Any person whose temperature exceeds 38°C shall not be permitted into the event.

The Club will **retain records including addresses** of all competitors/team members, officials and marshals who attend the event.

The Organiser is to ensure parking at the venue is sufficient to ensure adequate social distancing.

4. Signing-on

Face masks and PPE must be worn by both parties

Social distancing markers to be laid down at 2 metre intervals.

Clerk of Course final instructions to be displayed at signing on and/or at designated locations, this will replace riders briefing. A record of all who have read these final instructions, will be retained.

5. Practice/Race

Marshals to observe social distancing.

The Club shall provide Marshals/Technical Inspectors with PPE/masks/visors/hand sanitiser.

6. End of Meeting

No licences record cards to be signed at events.

Riders advised to retain results for submission with 2022 licence application.
